- 2. Can I prepare an Erasmus+ application even if I am only one teacher? We believe professional development of teachers is not a task for one single teacher: it is a task for a team. When you go abroad, we recommend to take one or more of your fellow teachers with you: together you will accomplish so much more. We strongly recommend you create a small internal team of dedicated teachers and staff of your school.
