The new Erasmus+ 2021-2027

A great opportunity!

• Funding from €14.7 billion (2014-2020) to €28 billion (2021-2027)

- More funding, more opportunities for schools
- More green, more digital, more inclusive
- Simplified procedure: it is worth applying now for new comers and less experienced organisations!!

Why to participate?

- Learn new skills and knowledge
- Find new resources
- Transfer to practice
- Network and influence

Who can participate

- Organisations:
 - Only organisations can apply, not individuals
 - The applicant must be a school or a consortium
 - Based in EU + Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia, Turkey and Serbia UK government opted out of the Erasmus+ scheme (Brexit)
- Participants can be teachers and staff (and students!)

Erasmus+ sectors

- Erasmus+ covers many sectors (sometimes called "fields"):
 - school education
 - vocational education and training (VET)
 - adult education
 - higher education
 - youth
 - sport
- Contact <u>your Erasmus+ National Agency</u> if you are unsure what sector your organization belongs to

Key Actions and their activities

Key Action 1 = mobility

• Staff mobility

- Job shadowing (2 to 60 days)
- Teaching assignments (2 to 365 days)
- Course and training (2 to 30 days)
- Learner mobility

POSSIBLE

(easy)

MAIN FOCUS

- Group mobility of school pupils (2 to 30 days, at least 2 pupils per group)
- Short-term learning mobility of pupils (10 to 29 days)
- Long-term learning mobility of pupils (30 to 365 days)

Other supported activities

- Invited experts (2 to 60 days)
- Hosting teachers and educators in training (10 to 365 days)
- Preparatory visits

• Key Action 2 = cooperation

Partnership for cooperation

- Cooperation partnership projects
- Small scale partnership projects
- (requires Partnership for excellence
 - Partnership for innovation
 - Alliances for Innovation
 - Capacity building
 - Sport events

• Key Action 3 = policy

• Jean Monnet Actions = training about EU matters

How to participate to Key Action 1 mobilities

1 - Apply for funding

- Short-term mobility projects 🖛 MAIN FOCUS
- Accredited projects (accreditation deadline in October + budget request)

2 - Join without an application

- Join a mobility consortium (Ask your NA and please recommend us)
- Host Erasmus+ participants

Short-term mobility projects

- Project duration from 6 to 18 months
- Maximum 3 projects in 5 years time
- One project per round (per sector!)
- Maximum 30 mobilities per project
- Priority to new comer and less experienced organisations

Selected deadlines

- 23rd February 2023: Key Action 1 Mobility projects first round
- 22nd March 2023: Key Action 2 Small scale partnership projects
- Results are published in the summer and activities can start from September or later
- 2024 Erasmus+ call published in Autumn and 2024 Key Action 1 deadline probably in Feb 2024.

6 steps to fund your teacher training course

1. Leave plenty of time for planning and writing Erasmus+ KA1 Project

- Planning and writing your KA1 project
- Choose the right application form
- 2. Choose the right course(s) for your needs
- 3. OID number
- 4. Contact your National Agency for more information or training
- 5. Fill in the form and submit
- 6. Success!

Planning and writing your KA1 project

- Reading carefully (school sector)
 - pages 4-14, pages 37-41, pages 104-113 of the <u>2023 Erasmus+ Programme guide</u> and the <u>2022 Erasmus+ model application forms</u>.
 - If you have your OID, online applications form are <u>available here</u>.

Short-term projects for mobility of learners and staff in adult education (KA122-ADU)

Short-term projects for mobility of learners and staff in school education (KA122-SCH)

Short-term projects for mobility of learners and staff in vocational education and training (KA122-VET)

- All applicants are required to submit the <u>online application form</u> to the appropriate National Agency of their country
- VERY IMPORTANT: Ask you National Agency if you are unsure about what sector you belong

Study the structure of the application form

Choose the right courses

- <u>Our courses</u>.
 - Six learning areas
 - Available dates and locations.
- <u>Confirmed courses</u>
- To be confirmed vs confirmed!
- <u>Pre-registration</u> for courses in 2024
- Customised courses and other topics: tell us more!

Assignment

Factors to consider when choosing our courses

- Language skills:
 - Language learning or professional development
 - Language barriers
- Compensating the carbon footprint of your travel:
 - Incorporate green practices: Grow a tree
 - We offset your carbon emissions from your travel by taking care of a tree!
 - You can score more points!

Your project could be a combination of more courses

- Help us reach the minimum number of participants:
 - Max 30 participants per short-term mobility
 - Not one participant per course, not too many courses
- Teacher training courses
 - Language learning courses:
 - English Level 1, English Level 2, Italian
 - Make your school digital:
 - <u>STEM and digital education</u>
 - Make your school green:
 - Education for Sustainable Development: ideas and activities for your class,
 - UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals: from lesson-planning to teaching,
 - Bringing biodiversity into the classroom
 - Customised courses and other topics

Getting your OID

• OID = Organisation ID. It identifies organisations in Erasmus+ projects

Assignment

- Search for your organisation
- Register your organisation, only if not already registered
 - EU Login
 - <u>Register your OID</u>

Contact your National Agency if you need help

Award criteria

- Short-term mobility projects will be assessed against the following criteria: (details for school sector at page 112 of the Programme Guide)
 - Relevance of the project (30 points)
 - Quality of the project design (40 points)
 - Quality of the follow-up actions (30 points)
- Winning the grant means scoring many points!
