
Learners

#### Our prices and your budget

- Our prices
- Teacher training courses:
  - Your Erasmus+ grant will cover ALL necessary costs, including travel, accommodation and course/tuition fee.
  - Our invoice + our estimates of your other costs
- Programmes for pupils and VET learners
  - Might require co-financing
  - Depends on a number of factors. Up to 350€ per participant
- We do not organize student mobilities. We are committed to teacher training

- You can apply for up to 30 mobilities. How many participants for the following activities?
  - Courses and training (teachers only)
  - Group mobility of school pupils (pupils)
  - Short-term learning mobility of school pupils (pupils)

- Green travel is not the same as "Grow a Tree"




