



GETTING IN MILAN

By car

If you want to reach Milan by car pay attention to the several **ZTL zone**, areas in which car traffic is restricted. Please check [this website](#) for information on the restricted areas.

By train

Milan is one of the main railway nodes for the entire country. Many lines start or pass through “Milano Centrale” the city’s central station, notably from:

- **Turin:** 50 minutes;
- **Venice** (it usually includes a stop in Verona): two hours and a half ride;
- **Rome:** three hours ride;
- **Naples:** five hours ride.

From Milano Centrale to the city center:

- **by taxi:** taxi waiting area in front of the station or call +39 028585;
- **by bus:** there are several bus lines stopping near the station. Please check the official [webpage](#) for information on the buses and fees;
- **by metro:** there are several metro lines stopping at the station. You can use the same website as the buses to check all public transportation in Milan;

By plane

Aeroporto Malpensa is the main airport of Milan even if it is a bit far from the city. From this airport you can reach the centre in the following ways:

- **by taxi** (from 50 minutes): taxi waiting area in front of the airport or call (+39) 0331 231312 or (+39) 02 6969.
- **by bus**: there are several options to go from the airport to the city centre. You can find all options with timetables and available stops on the following [website](#).
- **by train**: You can use the Malpensa Express, there is a train every 30 minutes and it stops at several train stations along the way with the final stop in Milano Centrale. All the



information on the timetable and trains are available on the [website](#).

Aeroporto Linate: one of the other airports serving the city and the nearest one to the centre. From this airport you can reach the centre in the following ways:

- **by metro**: metro line M4 reaches Linate airport from Milan in less than 20 minutes. Please check the official [webpage](#) for information on the metro and fees.

- **by taxi**: taxi waiting area in front of the airport or call +39 02 7777 or use the app MiT (Milano in Taxi).

Aeroporto Orio al Serio: the last airport serving the city and the furthest one from the centre. From this airport you can reach the centre in the following ways:

- **by bus**: there are several options to reach Milano Centrale train station from Orio al Serio airport. Some of the options are:

Getting around the city

On foot
