



GETTING IN BILBAO

By car

Bilbao is located in the north of Spain so it can be reached quite easily from a good part of Spain and other countries like France and Portugal. Please check <u>this website</u> for information on the restricted areas and parking spots.

By train

Bilbao is connected with the biggest cities in Spain and some cities in France and Portugal. Many lines converge into the city's central station called "Bilbao Abando Indalecio Prieto", notably from:

Madrid: 4 hours and a half ride;

• Paris: 6 hours ride.



From the train station, the best way to reach the city center is by foot (it only takes around 10 minutes). Otherwise, you can use public transport and for this, you can find more information here.

By plane

There is only one airport serving Bilbao, from the airport you can reach the center in the following ways:

• **by taxi**: taxi waiting area in front of the airport or you can call (+34) 944 800 909 or book trough the official <u>website</u>.



• **by bus**: there are several bus lines connecting the airport to the city center. More information is available on the official <u>website</u>.

Getting around the city



On foot

Bilbao is a relatively small city so it is pretty easy to walk around the center and all monuments are at a walkable distance from each other. By foot is also the best way to enjoy and admire the city with its narrow and characteristic streets!

By public transport
